Extending Specialized Neurological Care, Free of Cost

For residents of towns like Madanapalle, neurological conditions have traditionally meant expensive trips to major cities for specialized care, with significant costs for travel, accommodation, and long appointment waits. Swaasthya Hospital is changing this narrative.

Our bi-monthly Neurology Camps, led by acclaimed Neurosurgeon and Swaasthya's Medical Director Dr. Venkataramana, bring advanced neurological care directly to the community—completely free of cost. This is the same caliber of expertise found in metropolitan hospitals, supported by state-of-the-art diagnostic technology, now available locally.

Each camp sees an average of 55-70 patients, many of whom benefit from comprehensive evaluations, expert diagnosis, and compassionate follow-up. Those needing further evaluation are supported by our in-house facilities, including a 64-slice CT scanner and digital X-ray setup that delivers results in under five minutes. Patients who require surgery receive thorough counseling and are guided with clear next steps for treatment.

Swaasthya Hospital is ensuring that geography and economic constraints never prevent access to expert neurological care.

Outreach in Action: One Purpose, Many Places

Outreach continues to be a vital part of our healthcare mission—grounded in the belief that access to quality medical care should not be determined by geography or income. Both Swaasthya Hospitals in Madanapalle and The Satsang Foundation's Nagpur Kendra continuously extend their services, meeting communities where they are.

Swaasthya Hospitals: Rural Awareness Camps

Recent awareness-focused medical camps were held in Chippili Village (87 participants) and CTM Village (74 participants) as part of Swaasthya's ongoing rural outreach program.

These camps addressed common issues such as joint pain, respiratory difficulties, diabetes complications, and hypertension—conditions often worsened by reliance on unqualified practitioners and unsafe medications like steroids and painkillers. The Swaasthya team worked to demystify these ailments, highlight the risks of unregulated treatments, and guide participants toward safe, affordable care through its charitable model.

Nagpur Kendra: Primary Care in Rural Vidarbha

On May 10, 2025, despite intense 45°C heat, The Satsang Foundation's Nagpur Kendra conducted an outreach camp at Gram Panchayat, Borkhedi (Railway), serving 75 individuals from nearby villages.

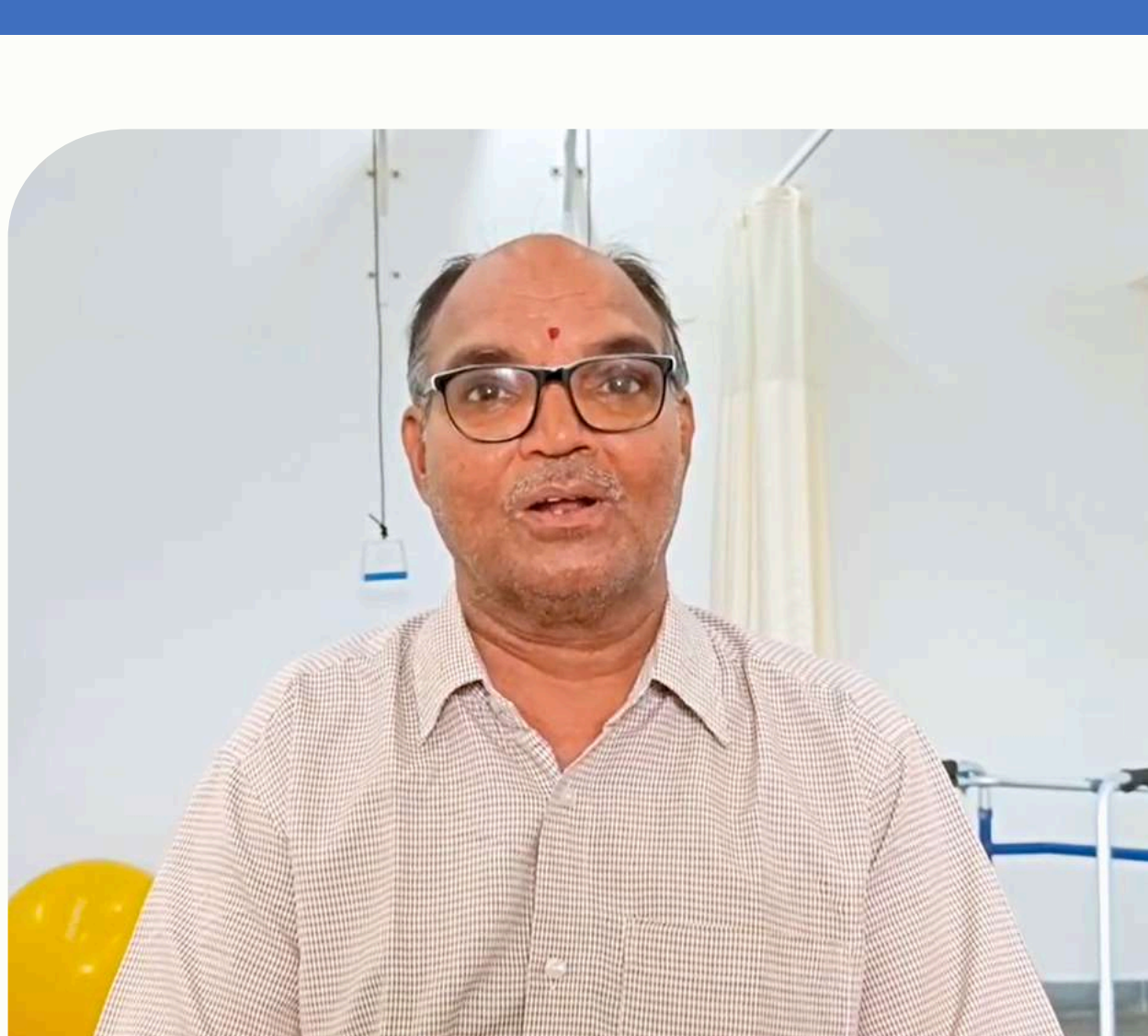
The camp offered free medical consultations, vital check-ups and diagnostic testing (blood sugar, ECG, X-rays), free medications with an average cost of ₹80 per patient, and hygiene awareness. Twenty participants were referred for further specialist consultation, with focus on older populations and those with limited healthcare access.

Whether through Swaasthya Hospitals' structured ecosystem or Nagpur Kendra's volunteer-led network, these outreach efforts embody a shared ethos: go where the need is, and serve with care and credibility. United in intent, they reach the unreached and uphold health as a fundamental right.

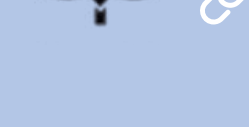
